The children started their athletics skills programme this week. Thanks to the following parents for helping. As you can see, we still have a few gaps, so if you'd like to help, please phone school with your offers.

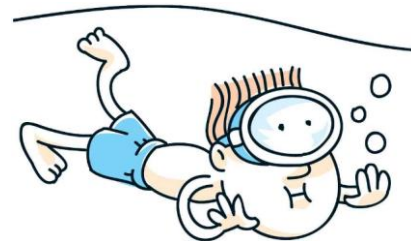
