## Pistachio Truffles

**Botanical name:** Roly Polyii

**Where to grow:** Lunch boxes, tramping, after school, party nibbles

**Fundamentals for good growth:**

- 100g dark choc
- ¼ c unsweetened cacao powder (or normal cocoa)
- 1cup medjool dates (I use dried dates soaked in hot water)
- 1cup almond meal
- ½ cup shelled pistachio nuts
- 2TBS honey
- 1/3cup butter or coconut oil
- Coconut for coating

**How to grow:**

Put all ingredients in the food processor & a pinch of salt. Roll into balls, coat in coconut. Refrigerate.
