We are looking forward to our trip to the Southland Museum on Friday 7 August.

Programme

8.30am - as soon as all school bus runs are in the Ritchies coach will depart from Mararoa School.

10.30am - Morning tea at Queens Park.

11.00am - Kaupapa Maori Programme at Southland Museum.

Students will learn how the early Maori people lived and about Maori culture by exploring the Maori gallery, as well as learning about Maori art, games and musical instruments. They will also make some Rewena bread as part of their focus on kai and tour the WW1 exhibition. The cost of this visit is \$2 per student to cover materials. This will be charged to your stationery accounts.

1.00pm - Lunch at Queens Park.

2.00pm - Coach departs Queens Park for Mararoa School.

3.45/4pmish - Coach arrives at Mararoa School. We will be too late to catch the school buses so parents will need to make arrangements to collect your own children from school. Te Anau children may remain on the coach and will be delivered to the Events Centre.

Children are to wear school uniform. They will need a warm, weather proof jacket, appropriate footwear, and their hi- viz vests. Please ensure they have plenty to eat - morning tea, lunch, afternoon tea and a full water bottle.
